



Family Advocacy Centers Fact Sheet

- WHAT:** The mission of the Family Advocacy Center is to provide free services to all victims of crime, specializing in sexual abuse and domestic violence. A New Leaf's Advocacy Program receives funding through the Victims of the Crime Act (VOCA) grant.
- WHO:** Victims of crime complete a screening and assessment for services. Based on eligibility, the client will be provided, at no cost, by one of six A New Leaf's Counselors based in three Valley Advocacy Centers; West Valley, Phoenix, and Mesa.
- WHEN:** Services are available Monday through Friday with some evening and weekend appointments available.
- HOW:** Each of the three Centers has an on-site Master's level Counselor who provides short-term crisis counseling, group therapy and referrals for step-up therapy services at no cost to the client. The purpose of the crisis counseling is to stabilize the client, develop a support network, and increase levels of functioning.
