Community Assistance Program for the City of Mesa

WHAT:

Community Assistance Program

MesaCAN's Community Assistance Program offers financial and case management services to individuals and families who are facing an immediate crisis which impacts on their housing, utilities, health and safety. City of Mesa residents apply and are qualified per poverty guidelines and state regulations.

Individual Development Accounts (IDA)

IDAs are savings accounts designed to help working individuals and families save for homeownership, educational and small business startup expenses. Upon completion of the IDA program, matching funds are disbursed to appropriate parties for asset purchases.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

IRS trained volunteers electronically prepare and file returns for low and moderate income individuals and families each February through April 15.

Weatherization

Created through the U.S. Department of Energy, the Weatherization Program seeks to decrease cost of utilities for homes of low-income families by examining and improving the efficiency of their utilities. MesaCAN's office provides Weatherization to residents of Mesa who qualify with proof of income.
