WHAT: A 24-hour therapeutic environment for adolescent males, ages 12-17, who experience emotional or interpersonal problems within their family or community and whose behaviors have led to involvement in the Maricopa County Juvenile Court System. Program includes individual and group therapy, case management and resourcing, family counseling, life skills development and education.

WHO: Clients are referred through the Maricopa County Juvenile Court Centers.

WHEN: A New Leaf has been operating Residential Treatment Centers for adolescents since 1974. Alice Peterson Detention Alternative Program opened in 2006.

HOW: Licensed by the Department of Health Services as a Level III Group Home and accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO).
