- has attested that it plans to continue spending at least fifty percent of its budget in the future on services to Arizona residents who receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) benefits or to Arizona resident low-income households or to individuals with a chronic illness or physical disability who are Arizona residents; and
- has attested that it does not provide, pay for, or provide coverage for abortions; nor does it financially support any other entity that provides, pays for, or provides coverage for abortions.
