The **REACH** (Resiliency, Empowerment, Advocacy, Community, Healing) Center is part of A New Leaf's Sexual Violence Survivor Advocacy & Support Services (SVSASS). This program addresses the unique, short- and long-term emotional safety and healing needs of those who have experienced sexual violence in the past and/or present.

Services are survivor-driven, and healing-centered, providing individualized support and empowerment for survivors of all genders, sexual orientations, and expressions. REACH Advocates provide survivors a supportive space to be heard, believed, and empowered on their healing journey.
